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Welcome to UNIZA

We are glad to welcome you to the University of Žilina. This guidebook will supply you with basic information about us, the country, transportation, accommodation, sightseeing and much more. The University of Žilina (UNIZA) is a modern university with a rich tradition. It currently educates nearly **8,000 students** in **203 accredited study programs**. Over its 70-year history, it has produced over **95,000 graduates**, specializing mainly in transport, engineering, management, marketing, and humanities. UNIZA offers education at six faculties and two Institutes.

The University of Žilina campus is located in a quiet green area near a forest park, within walking distance of accommodation facilities and the historical city centre. The campus is compact and easily walkable. Most buildings and services are reachable within 10 minutes on foot.

Transport

Convenient connection to the Žilina from the nearest airport:



- **VIENNA**

From the airport in Vienna you can easily get to the capital of Slovakia - Bratislava by bus.

Route from Vienna airport to the bus station Bratislava Nivy. You can use 3 shipping companies. [Flixbus](#), [Slovak Lines](#) and [RegioJet](#). You can find their current timetable.

From the railway station (Hlavná stanica) you can take the [train directly to Žilina](#).



- **PRAGUE**

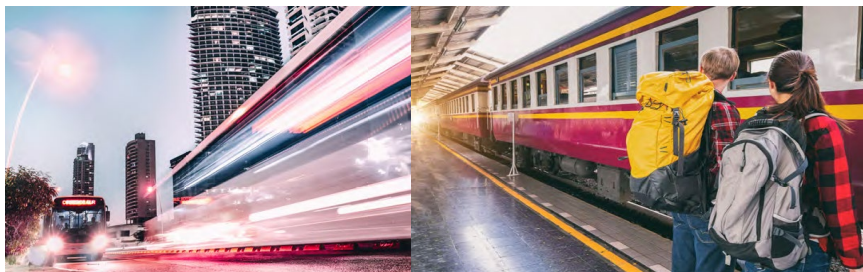
From the airport you can get to the [bus](#) and [train](#) station by bus.

- **BRATISLAVA**

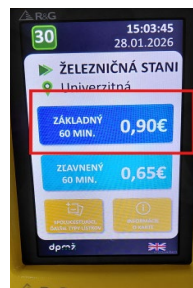

How to get from railway station to campus? You have many possibilities:

Public transport

- **Payment by card**
 - » After boarding, use the yellow ticket validator
 - » Select Pay by card on the display
 - » Tap your payment card or NFC device (supported: Visa, Mastercard, Maestro, Apple Pay, Google Pay, Garmin Pay)
 - » Ticket Price **0.90 €**



- **Paper Tickets**
 - » Available at ticket machines at bus stops and newspaper kiosks
 - » Ticket machines accept euro coins
- **SMS Tickets**
 - » Send a blank SMS to 1155
 - » Price: **1.10 €**
 - » Valid for 60 minutes
 - » You may board only after receiving the confirmation SMS

Taxi

- » Taxis operate 24/7
- » Starting fare is usually around **3 €**, with the final price depending on distance
- » Prices are comparable to other European cities
- » BOLT services available in Žilina

- **Kia bike**
 - » KIA Bike is a popular and eco-friendly way to move around the city.
 - » **Download the app**
 - » ⚠ Just a reminder that in Slovakia you're not allowed to ride a bike on the sidewalks.

First 15 minutes: **FREE**

- » Additional 15 minutes (up to 60 minutes): **0.25 €**
- » Maximum daily charge: **100 €**

- **BOLT electric scooter**
 - » Available throughout the city
 - » Locate and unlock scooters via the **Bolt app**
 - » ⚠ Just a reminder that in Slovakia you're not allowed to ride a electric scooter on the sidewalks.

What to see in Žilina

Žilina and its surroundings offer a variety of cultural, historical, and leisure attractions, all easily accessible from the city centre.

- **Budatín Castle**

Budatín Castle is one of the most important historical landmarks in Žilina. The castle houses the Považie Museum and is known for its unique collection of wire art (tinkering). The surrounding park is ideal for a relaxing walk.

- **Church of the Conversion of St. Paul the Apostle**

Located on Mariánske Námestie, this Baroque church dates back to 1754. Its twin towers dominate the historical city centre and are a distinctive feature of Žilina's skyline.

- **Považská Gallery of Art**

Situated on Andrej Hlinka Square, this gallery is housed in a Neoclassical building and features modern and contemporary Slovak art, as well as temporary exhibitions.

- **Rosenfeld Palace**

Rosenfeld Palace is an important cultural venue offering exhibitions, concerts, lectures, and discussions focused on contemporary art, design, and urban culture.

- **Vrba–Wetzler Memorial Room**

This memorial commemorates Rudolf Vrba and Alfréd Wetzler, who escaped from Auschwitz in 1944. The exhibition presents a powerful historical testimony and is recommended for visitors interested in modern European history.

- **Malá Fatra National Park**

Hiking and nature experiences (day trip)

Most attractions are within walking distance or easily reachable by public transport.

Useful Information

- **Tap water is safe to drink**

Slovakia has the second-largest reservoir of drinkable water in all of Europe. **You Can Drink the Tap Water.** When dining out at cafes and restaurants, be sure to ask for a glass of water instead of a bottle.

- **Currency & Payments**

The official currency in Slovakia is the euro (€). Credit and debit cards are widely accepted, and contactless payments are common. However cash is also needed.

- **Electricity**

Slovakia uses a **230 V / 50 Hz electricity system.** Power plugs are type C and E. Visitors from outside Europe may need a power adapter.

- **Weather & Clothing**

Slovakia is located in the temperate climate zone with a regular alternation of the four seasons.

- **Emergency & Health**

The emergency number in Slovakia is 112. Pharmacies (“Lekárne”) are widely available.

- **Safety**

Slovakia is considered a safe country. Nevertheless, visitors are advised to take standard precautions and keep personal belongings secure.
